(PART I) - Priority Matters

(PART II) - Updates from Council Members

A. President (Rolan V.)

1. 2T2 Holiday Social Updates

2. PEBC Information Session Update

- iii. Happening live to bring some connection to a very disconnected time
- iv. Flexibility with timing: 15 mins to 1.5 hours... whatever works best for people
- v. At least 1-2 council members to help make advertisements for social media sharing
 1. Judy said she will assist with ad designs
- vi. Start the week of Jan 25th
 1. Tentative date: Wednesday January 27th 9:30-11:00 AM
- vii. Keeping time range open so people can drop in and out
5. **IDEA #2: "2T2ASTE" (Take A 2T2 Student To Eat)**
 - i. Part-matchmaker part-affle
 - ii. Matchmaker survey with certain qualities or random matching (student-choice)
 - iii. Matchmaking algorithm using Excel
 - iv. Council is encouraged to assist with marketing or creating questions to use for matchmaker form.
 - v. Costs of raffle prize will be covered Rolan with no reimbursement requests.

 1. Buy dinner for students
 2. Tips for students regarding residency
 - a. Bidding kind of process to attend for multiple bidders
 - iv. Raise funds for 1 charity with all class councils and pool in all the donations; send out option to all classes for class engagement
 1. Council auction might not be an event due to the combined class effort
 - v. How to conduct class council auction?
 1. Council members usually absorbs the cost of the activity they are doing
 - a. Is it possible to conduct right now?
 - b. Looking for more prizes?
 - i. More hands off rather than hands on due to COVID



- ii. Could buy a couple of gift cards for students and the gifts are in the raffle

- vi. Questions:
 - 1. Is class council member participation mandatory?

1. **2T2 Athletics Instagram Page**
 - i. Invite all 2T2s to follow this weekend with a launch on this coming Monday
 - ii. 3 posts per week plus extras when needed
 - iii. Monday post: a physical activity challenge for the week (M → F). Participants can send videos of themselves completing the challenges directly to the instagram account, or they can message for credit or the activity.
 - iv. Wednesday post: Toronto Teams Update. Update around the standings, upcoming games and anything exciting going on with our home teams.
 - v. Friday post: a leaderboard for the Monday physical activity challenge. Will be based on self-reported numbers of activities completed.
 - vi. Ideas for less regular posts - learn about a new sport (looking for guest volunteers to explain a unique sport they play in a short video) and nomination challenges to get more people involved
